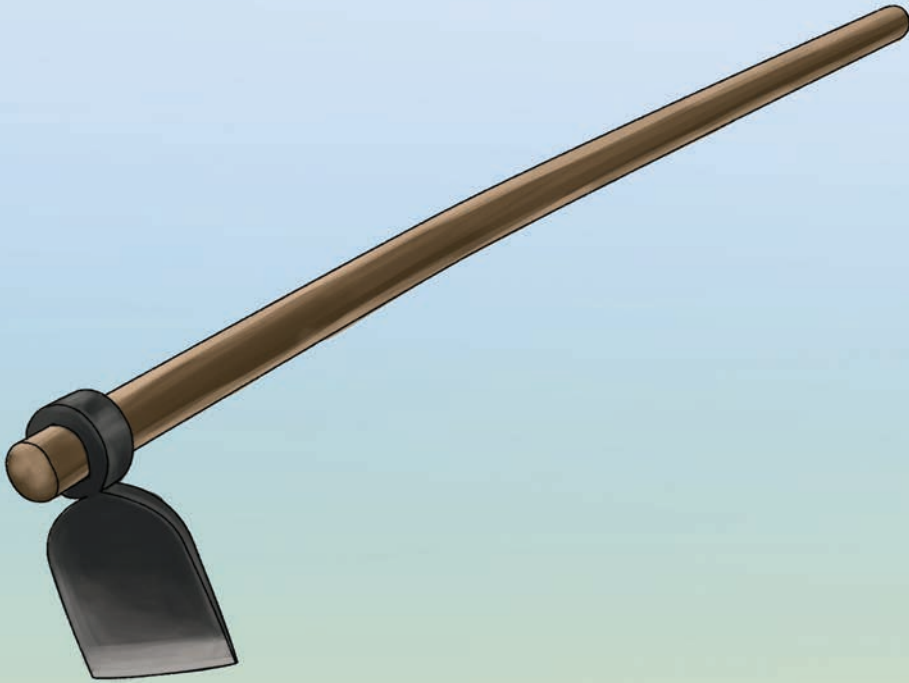
A day on the farm

We use the tools in the farm.



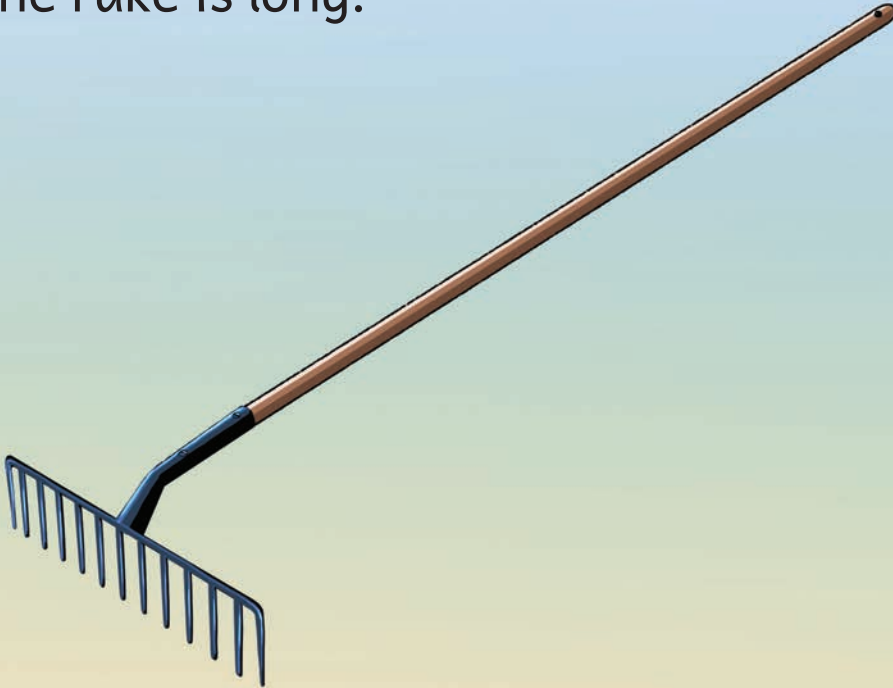


This is a hoe.
